### EDITION AND OUTLINE OF THE TEXT

Editor: Word for Windows (NOT the Open Office) Font: Times New Roman 12 . In tables TNR 11 or TNR10 are accepted. Bold – only titles and subtitles of chapters and the author's name Italic – only Latin names of species and words Text: single spaced, double between chapters Citations in the text: (Nowak, Kowalski 2000), (Kowalski *et.al. 2001*) Tables: In Word for Windows, maximal width 150 mm, height 200 mm. Every table at a separate page. Description at the top. Citations in the text: (Tab.1). Graphics: In black and white only, Corel Draw, JPG, TIFF or BMP files accepted. Maximal dimensions: width 150 mm, height 200 mm. Every figure should be prepared as a separate file. Descriptions for figures at a separate page at the end of the text. Citations in the text: (Fig. 1). Photom et lacet 600 drie THEE on IDC in computer files. Descriptions of figures.

Photos: at least 600 dpi, TIFF or JPG, in separate files. Descriptions as for figures.

# Citations of original papers in an alphabet different then Latin should be transcripted according to ISO recommendations.

- 6. Chapters: Introduction, Study area, Materials and Methods, Results, Discussion,
- Acknowledgements
- 7. References

# **PRESENTATION** (not peer-reviewed, in Polish or English, up to 5 pages without tables and figures)

- 1. Title
- 2. Author (s)
- 3. Affiliation (name of the institution, e-mail address)
- 4. Abstract or a summary (at least half page) in English for Polish texts, or in Polish

for English texts

5. Key words (up to 5)

6. Text continuous or divided into chapters (up to the author)

7. References
